

## Infrastructure Contributions

The figures below are payable by property owners who are taking up new connections to the various sewerage and water supply services in the Masterton District.

The contribution is the 'buy in' price for new joiners that connect to the services.

All contributions are payable prior to connection.

All prices are GST exclusive.

<b>New connection to Masterton urban services</b>	<b>\$5,000.00 (plus GST)</b> per residential equivalent connection
Nominal split between services:	Sewer \$3,000.00 (plus GST) Water \$2,000.00 (plus GST)

This contribution is payable by subdividers/developers under the new Wairarapa Combined District Plan, as part of issuing resource consent for new lots. The charge is effectively a joining fee to join the existing network services. For all other new connections the contributions are payable by the owner prior to connection.

Developers may be required to pay additional contributions depending on their development's assessed impact on the future network upgrade needs.

<b>Upper Plain water</b> (trickle feed off urban supply)	<b>\$2,666.67 (plus GST)</b> plus connection costs (restriction valve, backflow valve etc)
<b>Other Rural (metered) on urban water</b>	<b>\$2,000.00 (plus GST)</b> plus connection costs (restriction valve, backflow valve etc)
<b>Rural – connection to urban sewer</b>	<b>\$3,000.00 (plus GST)</b>
<b>Airport – additional cost recovery for Hood Airport water and sewer lines</b>	additional <b>\$2,982.00 (plus GST)</b> and <b>\$4,227.00 (plus GST)</b> respectively
<b>Tinui sewerage</b>	<b>\$8,000.00 (plus GST)</b>
<b>Tinui water supply</b>	<b>\$3,200.00 (plus GST)</b>
<b>Castlepoint sewerage</b>	<b>\$4,500.00 (plus GST)</b>
<b>Taueru water supply</b>	<b>\$4,000.00 (plus GST)</b>
<b>Riversdale Beach sewerage</b>	<b>\$20,444.44 (plus GST)</b>
