> Implementation Plan 2019/20 - 2020/21

The implementation plan for the first two years of the Arts, Culture and Heritage Strategy (ACH) 2019-24 outlines projects that are planned to be undertaken in 2019/20 and 2020/21. These are new projects that will be funded via budgets confirmed as part of the 2018-28 Long-Term Plan.

The projects in this implementation plan are additional to funding for community and ACH sector organisations previously agreed to by Masterton District Council via planning processes (Annual or Long-Term Plans). The budget for these projects does not affect funding that is available through the Arts Fund, Events Fund; Community Wellbeing Fund; Creative Communities Scheme; and the Marae Development Fund.
